Fact Sheet Overview

This Fact Sheet outlines many of the local, state and federal rules and regulations that apply to waste haulers, recyclers, waste cooking oil processors and biodiesel producers. Non-compliant service providers increase liability risk to restaurant and commercial food facilities. Compliant service providers, on the other hand, may also reduce their customers' risk by maintaining all relevant insurance coverage. Ask your waste cooking oil provider for evidence of insurance coverage, and make sure you're getting 100% compliance and assurance!
